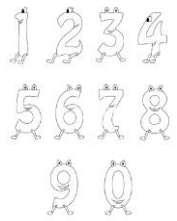

Maths

This week we have been sitting a set of sample maths papers. We have also been continuing consolidating our arithmetic skills by multiplying and dividing fractions, as well as practicing reasoning with times tables. For example, if I know $7 \times 8 = 56$, how can I solve 0.7×8 or 0.07×80 ? Once we have collated the results this will inform our planning and booster groups moving into the second half of the term.

This week in English we have worked hard on developing our narrative writing skills; particularly crafting engaging openings. Linking our work with Pig Heart Boy, we have also been looking at how the heart, lungs and circulatory system operate and the impact of exercise on heart rate and oxygen absorption.
