Our learning this week:

Maths: This week the children have been trying to multiply 2-digit numbers by a 1-digit number (eg 21 x 4). They have been using manipulatives (cubes etc) to help them.

English: This week we have been looking at playscripts, examining the features of a playscript, talking about stage directions and how to act them out. There is a CBeebies programme entitled "Gudrun Viking Princess" which we have used as a basis for writing our own playscripts. The drafting of their playscripts will start next week.

RE: We have continued with our Revelation topic, which this week involved a discussion with Deacon Geoffrey about how we hear the word of God through the Liturgy of the Word in the Mass. Next week the children will start to plan their own liturgy with psalms, readings and prayers.

Topic: With Mrs Tonkin, the children learnt about how the Vikings lived in settlements, and what equipment they might have needed. This has led into some very creative props for our assembly next week!
