
This week there are still some activities to do so please keep going with these!


Today, we need to plan our letter by thinking about the sorts of things you would like to include and tell Mrs. Kenway.

Use the ideas from the list above to create a plan ready to write tomorrow. You can plan however you like- a mind map, table or bullet point list.


Aim to have 4/5 different paragraphs so that is 4/5 of the different points from the list. Give yourself as much detail as possible so that you can write it tomorrow.






