RE THEME - REVELATION

This unit focuses on the distinction between 'looking' and 'seeing beyond'. Pupils take part in activities which help them to identify with an experience of unveiling; making the notion of revelation (revealing) present to them. They reflect on the people in their lives who enable them to be their true and best selves before breaking open the scripture. This unit focuses on the Baptism of Jesus to analyse the role that John the Baptist plays in enabling Jesus to be revealed as the Son of God. This leads on to an examination of the significance of their own baptism and the people in their lives who enabled their journey of faith to begin. The unit concludes with opportunities for the pupils to recognize that revelation is ongoing by considering people today who help us to 'see' God. They evaluate their own role in helping God to be 'seen' and known by others.

In English this week the children have again been reading, planning and writing Dreamtime stories, folk tales from Aboriginal culture. They have read and re-written 'The Lizard Man and the Creation of the Uluru' while focusing on using ambitious vocabulary, relative clauses and fronted adverbials, commas and linking paragraphs.

Fractions has been the focus in Maths this week. The children have been converting mixed numbers into improper fractions and consolidated division while their reasoning focus has been on area and perimeter.

<u>SCIENCE</u>

The children have explored the effect of gravity and the link between the weight and mass of an object.

<u>MUSIC</u>

The children have been singing as part of an ensemble, looking at Australia's unofficial national anthem, 'Waltzing Matilda.'
