Our learning this week:

Maths: We have been continuing to use the column method for subtraction. We have also been using the 'bar model' to add and subtract numbers. This consists of a bar divided into section allowing the children to make comparisons.


English: In English, we have started reading a new class text 'Dinosaurs Awake'; the focus has been on using clues from the text to think about how plots and characters are developed (known as 'inference skills') and make predictions about what they think might happen. They have also been writing

character profiles of the main characters using evidence from the story. They have also been looking at comparative adjectives (big, bigger, biggest) and looking at the rules for spelling these words.
