This week we have been learning:-

English:

In English we have been learning how to write a persuasive letter. We have been using formal language and modal verbs to make our letter as persuasive as possible.

Spellings:

We have been learning words that end with the 'shus' sound which can be spelt -tious or -cious.

<u>Maths:</u>

In Maths we have been reading and interpreting line graphs. We have also been practicing some place value techniques.

Homework Tasks.

English:

Maths:

Write down 3 five digit numbers. Make sure that there is a 5 in the hundreds column. Round each number to the nearest 100, 1000 and 10000.

For example, 73549 to the nearest 100 = 73500

73549 to the nearest 1000 = 74000

73549 to the nearest 10000 = 70000
