This week we have been learning:-

What a FABULOUS week we have had. Nothe Fort was amazing and the children behaved beautifully and have learnt a lot.

<u>English</u>: We have been writing a recount of our visit to Nothe Fort. From this piece of work, I will then decide what the children's writing targets should be.
