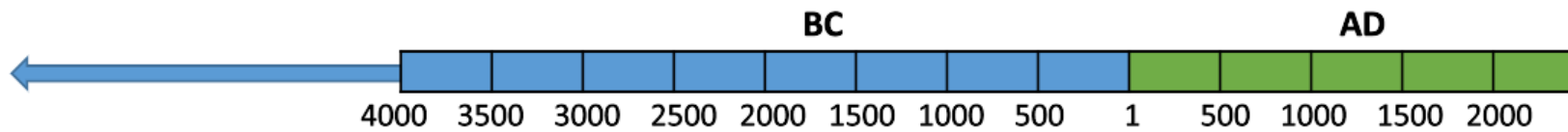

2 points	Choose an Ancient Egyptian symbol that was used in paintings e.g. Eye of Horus Draw the symbol and write an explanation of what it means.	Using a computer, create a timeline to show when Ancient Egypt existed. (The overall narrative timeline can be found below to help you).	Design a poster to teach others about the various areas of fitness and how they can develop them.	Write an explanation of Aristotle's Classification System and give an example of how it is used.
5 points	What did Ancient Egypt have in common with the Shang Dynasty? Create a table of similarities and differences.	Create a mummy using any materials you have at home.	Create your own collage using the techniques we have been learning in school such as overlapping and overlaying. Could you make a collage that represents you and what you are interested in?	Write a diary entry as a person living in Ancient Egypt talking about their daily life.
7 points	Research Tutankhamun and Queen Nefertiti. Write down the top 5 facts you have found out about them.	Think about the organisms we have studied in science. Choose one of the organisms to build using your chosen materials. Label it with its physical features and key facts.	Create your own Ancient Egyptian wall painting (on paper!) to represent a part of modern life. It could show a scene from school, a scene from the bible or a scene from your life outside of school.	Write a recount of your best day ever. How did it start? What did you do? Who did you do it with? How did it make you feel? Why was it so great?
10 points	Why were the pyramids built and what were they used for? Write your answer using what you have learnt in lessons and what you have researched yourself to support your explanation.
