Thank you to everyone who has accessed our online learning platform 'Google Classrooms' this week and completed their spelling work. Again we have set our spellings via Google Classroom and you should see them as an assignment. Learn the spellings listed in preparation for out test next Friday (October 19th). Literacy

In Literacy we have continued writing narrative based upon a short clip entitled 'Tabula Rasa'. The children have now retold the story and have written their own imagined version whilst incorporating the new knowledge we have picked up in our SPaG lessons this week.

Maths

In maths lessons we have looked at negative numbers in context. As the children have become more confident in this we have challenged them with word problems and activities associated with temperatures that are both above and below zero.

RE

In our RE lessons this week we have started our new topic that looks at the subject of 'mission'. We have thought about the definition of the word and how it applies to everyone. We have then looked in some detail at the mission undertaken by Marcus Rashford, the England footballer, to ensure that children have not gone hungry in these past few months.

Foundation Subjects

We have continued in our science lessons this week with the study of mammals and their life cycles. In art we have looked at the idea of symmetry and repetition and created some of our own pieces of work. We have focussed in music upon creating sounds associated with the Greek myth of Eurydice and Persephone and their journey to the underworld. Finally, in PSHE we have thought carefully about independence and responsibility and what they mean to us as individuals and a group.
