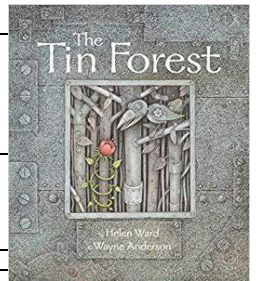


# Parents in Partnership
