CHURCH OPENING: During this lockdown, public Masses in the Parish will continue at normal times, including at weekends. The obligation to attend Holy Mass on Saturday Evening or Sunday remains suspended for the time being. Mass will continue to be streamed - if you can, join us by going to the parish website www.ourlady-starofthesea.com and then clicking the link which will take you straight to the live streaming. All who are shielding should continue to stay at home until the Government advises it is safe to venture out. Needless to say, our church premises and the way they are used must be a safe place, free if possible from Corona Virus, as well as a place of sacredness. In accordance with diocesan guidelines, the following rules must be STRICTLY adhered to:

- **1.** Entry to the church is by way of the front/main entrance **ONLY**.
- **2.** Exit from the church will be through the side door **ONLY**, and from there into the car park.
- **3.** All notices outlining procedures, including personal cleanliness and social distancing, must be adhered to.
- **4.** If on approaching the church, there seems to be too many people, then please **DO NOT ENTER** but return at another time.
- **5.** Face masks must be worn by all who attend (unless exempt).

The Parish Hall will remain closed.

NHS TEST & TRACE: In accordance with the Government's guidelines on the need for test & trace, those of you with smartphones can now use the NHS COVID-19 App and scan the QR code at the entrance to St Joseph's removing the need to write your details each visit. Those not using this App must continue to give your details in writing, which will be held for 3 weeks.

SPIRITUAL COMMUNION: Prayer of **St. Alphonsus.** My **Jesus**, I believe that you are present in this Holy Sacrament of the altar. I love you above all things and I passionately desire to receive you into my soul. Since I cannot now receive you sacramentally, come spiritually into my soul so that I may unite myself wholly to you now and forever. Amen. (Can be said at Communion whilst watching Holy Mass).

St. Augustine's School News: This week in school has been busty as the children have become involved in a range of Holy Week activities and liturgical events. On Monday we started **Holy Week** with our whole school liturgy. We focused on the gospel value of kindness as we reflected on the love that Jesus showed towards others. This liturgy was followed later in the day by our Palm Sunday Service, virtually led by our youngest children who enacted the story of Jesus riding through the streets of Jerusalem on a donkey. The children waved their palm leaves high and shouted 'hosanna.' It was a lovely service. As we have all reached the end of our Lent Topic in RE, the children have all engaged in class worship. On Thursday, our Year 6 children led us virtually in the Holy Thursday Service. They led prayers, scripture readings and enacted the Last Supper. It was a touching and thought-provoking service. We are proud of the way our Year 6's lead us in worship in such a mature and reverent way. Each class then held a simple Good Friday service in their own classes. We thank the parish for their generosity in providing us with a palm cross for each child. The children were grateful for this gift. We pray that the parishioners have a Happy and Peaceful Easter and we thank you for your support and prayers.

CHILDREN'S LITURGY: Today is Easter Sunday, when we celebrate Jesus rising from the dead. In the gospel (John 20:1-9), we hear Mary Magdalene comes to the tomb where Jesus' body has been laid. She sees that the stone, which blocked the entrance, has been moved. She runs to tell the disciples, and Peter and John run to the tomb to see what has happened. When they get there, they see that the tomb is empty except for the cloths that had been wrapped around Jesus' body. The disciples realise that Jesus is risen from the dead and they believe in him. Today is a time of joy, celebration and new life. Jesus defeated death, and his resurrection shows us that nothing is impossible to God. This fills us with great hope. Let's all show others our joy today and this coming week.
