As a Governing Body we have tried to keep the school uniform practical and easily available for purchase. Thus it is hoped that the uniform will affordable to parents.

Where this system is not available due to the different sizes and needs of pupils the governors are aware that other assistance may be sought from the school. A small budget to support such need may need to be allocated from the general school budget. Written applications will be required.

Vouchers can be allocated each year up to a maximum of £35 per child.
