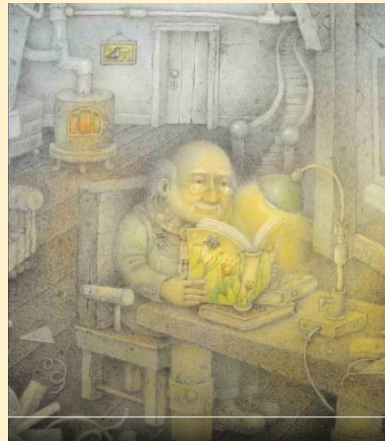

Write a simple witness statement about what you saw and heard when you got to the tomb.

Right in the middle was a small house, with small windows, that looked out on other people's rubbish and bad weather.

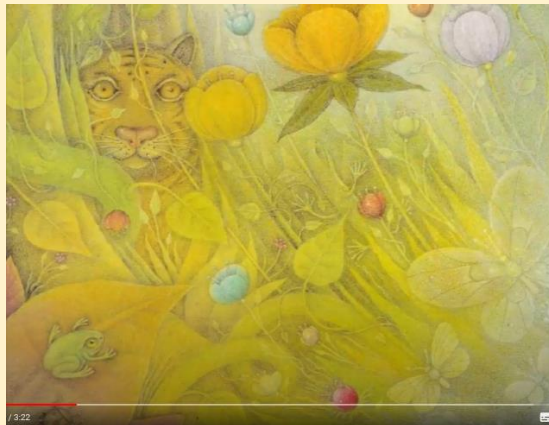


In the house lived an old man.
