

### Year 3 Creative Homework – The Romans



Draw a map showing how the Romans travelled to Britain.	Use some scrap materials to make a Roman-style mosaic.	Research the life of a famous Roman such as Julius Caesar, Augustus, Claudius or Hadrian.
Make up a quiz with facts about the Romans. Test your friends and family.	Design and create your own Roman shield.	Draw and label a picture of a Roman soldier.
Make a model of a Roman temple (or something else linked to the Romans).	Write a diary entry as a child living in Roman Britain.	Visit one of the many sites of interest with Roman connections in our local area and make your own leaflet or poster about it. (Try Maiden Castle, Maumbury Rings, The Roman Villa or Dorset County Museum in Dorchester; or the remains of Jordan Temple in Preston.)
Write a story or poem about the Romans.	Find out about Roman numerals and try using them to do some calculations.	Write and record a short rhyme for Roman soldiers to march to. Even better, perform it to us in school!

For your homework this half term, the Year 3 team would like you to be a little creative. Each week we would like you to choose a different activity from the grid to complete as your homework. You can choose any of the activities in any order, or you might have an idea for a different activity that you would like to try.

Please make sure that your completed homework is in school each Wednesday as we will have time to share your creations with the rest of the class.
