

In Maths we start most lessons by using the four operations. The children need to use these skills to answer problems in a real life context.

- Read the question more than once.
- Pick out the numbers you need to use.
- Look carefully at the words used and decide which operation to use to answer it.

Every week in English the children complete reading comprehension tasks. Read the text and answer the questions. In class we look for key words and sub-titles to find information. Then make sure the answer shows what the question is asking.

#### Times tables

The children have been tested on all the times tables with an emphasis on rapid recall (10 seconds). The times table they have been given is one in which they didn't get them all correct.

#### Spellings

The children have been tested on the Year 3 / 4 key words. The words they have been given are words they still need to learn.
