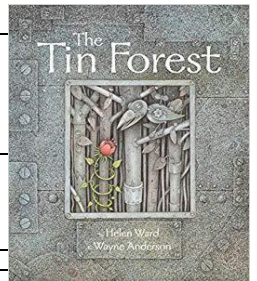


Parents in Partnership
