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<u>Maths</u>

This week we have learnt some simple algebra. We have been solving missing number problems by using inverse operations.

e.g 4y + 6 = 30 so to get 4y on its own you move the +6 the other side of the equals sign which becomes -6. 30-6 = 24, therefore 4y = 24. As 4y means four lots of y, to find the value of y move the 4 lots the other side of the equals to become the invers (divide) and $24 \div 4 = 6$. Therefore y = 6. The children have amazed me with this!
