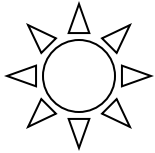
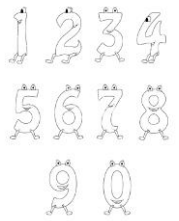

World Book Day

Math's

This week we have been revisiting 2D shapes. We have worked on drawing accurately and using rulers and protractors to construct angles. With the SATs fast approaching we will be revising a whole range of math's areas over the coming weeks

RE We have started to look at the feast of Lent and its importance in the Catholic calendar. Children will be given the opportunity to reflect at this important time and gain an insight into the importance of prayer, fasting and almsgiving.

Literacy

We have continued to focus upon the development of character in our narrative writing. We have identified a number of features that help characterisation and then employed them in our work. We will then use this in our independent writing.

Spelling and Grammar

This week we have been learning about pronouns, including possessive pronouns. We have learned how to identify them and then to utilise them in our writing to avoid repetition and provide variety.

In spelling lessons, we have continued to look at the application of prefixes to a variety of words to alter their meaning.
