## The Second World War

In English, the children have written setting descriptions, diary entries and newspaper reports based on the book, 'Rose Blanche.'

In Maths, the children have continued to focus on decimal numbers by solving problems in a real life context and multiplying and dividing decimal numbers by 10,100 and 1000. They have consolidated calculating fractions of amounts also looked at measures in their reasoning activities.
