RE WAGBAT: learning about Pentecost day by listening to Pentecost Day rhyme and drawing pictures to go with them.




As Sunday 31st May was Pentecost Day, we are learning about the coming of The Holy Spirit this week and the birthday of the Church.

Today, looking at The Resources for Today, you will see a print out of 2 rhymes linked to Pentecost Day, one of which we shared yesterday.


Please take time with your child to say the rhymes and then think about pictures that your child could draw to understand the signs and symbols we associate with Pentecost Day. Here are some examples.


















Topic WAGBAT: learning about plant growth by learning about what plants need to help them grow.
