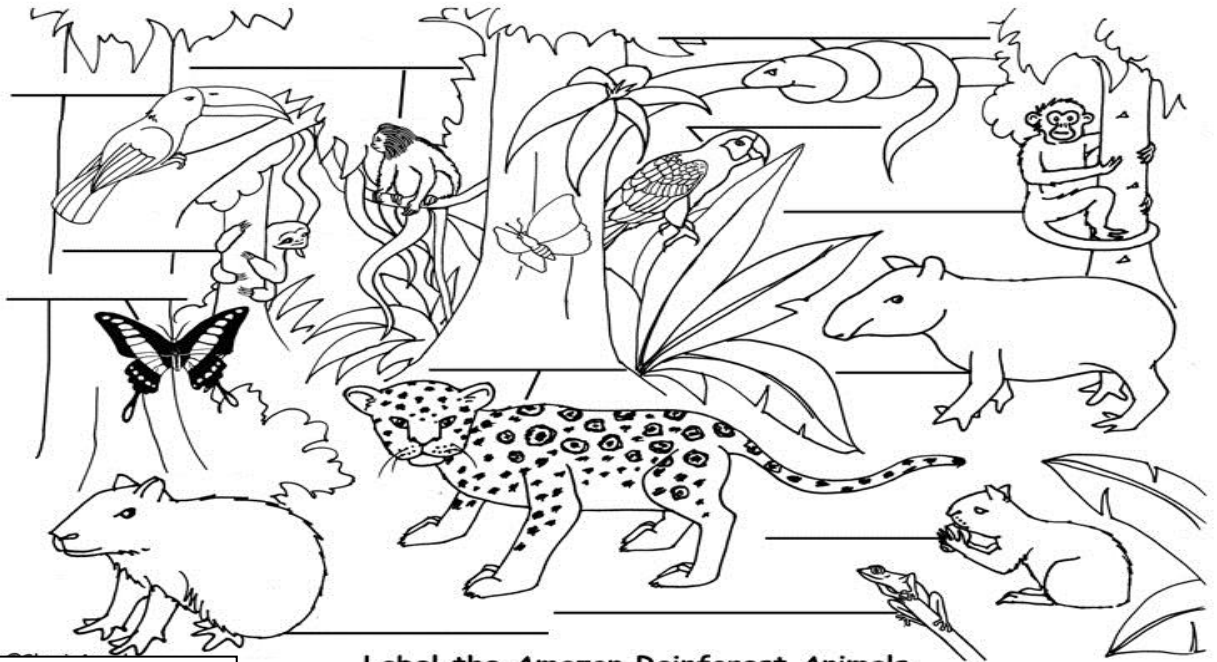
### Topic
