Draw fingers and nails on to both sides of the hands.








English WAGBAT: predicting what will happen next in a story.

In the house lived an old man.


Every day, he tried to clear away the rubbish, sifting and sorting, burning and burying.

What do you think the idea could be? What makes you think this? Think about what we have found out so far about the story and about the old man. Does the idea you are thinking of fit with what we know so far?


