The children had an inspirational day yesterday, when all the staff planned activities that involved outdoor learning.

Reception Class followed up earlier work on the senses by going on a 'Sensory Hunt' as they used their

senses of sight and touch to look for different textures in the environment, such as objects that were 'hard, soft, rough and smooth.' This provided a great opportunity to extend vocabulary!

Year 1's theme was Autumn Leaves. They searched high and low for different types of leaves, taking these back to the classroom to produce some autumn inspired art.

Year 2 used nature to inspire their art work too. They used natural found materials to create sculptures and collages and back in the classroom photographed their work.

Year 3 made shelters for their mini "Roman people" (Lego figures).

Years 4 and 5 produced lovely Autumn poetry based upon things they saw and found in the natural environment!

Year 6 were doing maths outside, finding the areas of different parts of the school environment using trundle wheels and calculating areas from their results.

We hope to have more learning like this soon!
