This week we have been learning:-

<u>English</u>: This week we have started a unit on writing a balanced argument. We have looked at 3 different arguments and worked out how they are presented. We have thought of reasons for and against taking a year out of school to sail around the world.

Homework Tasks.

Task 1:

Task 2:

Find out the times (to 3 decimal places) for the 100m final from the recent Commonwealth Games (men's and women's).

<u>OR</u> find out the times (to 3 decimal places) for the 50m freestyle swimming final from the recent Commonwealth Games (men's and women's).

OR find out the 10 winning times (to 3 decimal places) for the recent Chinese Grand Prix.

Explain how using decimals is important when deciding who wins the medals or championships. Make sure that you use the correct vocabulary for the columns after the decimal point e.g. tenths, hundredths. Also, make sure that you include examples from the information you have found.
