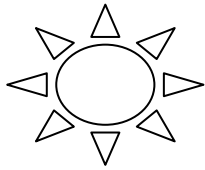

### Year 4 Class Newsletter

### Spellings

Children will be tested on Mondays. We have changed the way we are setting spellings. The children will all learn the first 5 spellings but then the next 5 will depend on the spelling group they are in. These groups are not fixed and your child may move between the groups depending on how they are doing in the tests. The results to their tests will be sent home every week so you can see how they are doing.
