This week we have been learning:-

English: We have revised how to add subordinate clauses to sentences to add extra detail. We have also learnt how to summarise a longer piece of writing so that only the most important key points are included.

Spellings: We have concentrated on revising the Y3/4 and Y5/6 spellings this week. We have tried speed spelling, writing them backwards, making up a chant or mnemonic to remember them and putting them into alphabetical order.

Maths: We have been learning to convert metric measurements from one form to another. For example, we measured our desk which was 1m and 20cm. This is 120cm and 1.2m. Also the Queen Elizabeth biography weighs 1kg and 800g which is 1.8kg or 1800g

Homework Tasks.

Task 1: Use the following words to create a complex sentence (one that includes a subordinate clause).

- 1) Night, stars, that, cold
- 2) Beach, windy, sand, waves
- 3) TV, favourite, programme
- 4) Friend, play, house

Challenge: Can you use one of these sets of words to write a sentence where you replace a conjunction with a semi colon ?

Maths:

Weigh or measure at least 5 objects in your house. Write down the weight or length and then convert the measurement.
