2 points	Draw a picture of a plant and label the parts.	Find a flower in your garden and draw a detailed picture of it.	Find out the names of some common flowers in your garden. Learn how to spell the words.	Draw pictures to show your understanding of half and quarter.
5 points	Find out about the different parts of the flower that create the seed. Draw a diagram and label it.	Create a collage by collecting flowers, pressing them between some books for a couple of weeks and then displaying them on a piece of paper or card.	Find out what a biography is and how it is different to an autobiography. Find an example of one of them and read it.	Find examples of fractions in real life. Write them down. Explain what they mean and how they are used.
10 points	Create a factfile about the 4 different types of plants. Make sure you include a description of what they look like, examples of the different variety of plants and diagrams to show the features.	Look at the different parts of a flower and create a model. Make sure you are as accurate as you can be.	Write a story about someone who discovers a new flower or plant. It could have magical powers. It could be poisonous. It might be the end of a quest. Make your story as imaginative as possible,	Ask an adult to give you 5 even numbers. Find half other the numbers and then see if you can find quarters of the numbers. Challenge - can you find halves of odd numbers?

You can choose which activities you do from this grid.

You must complete an activity from each area (A-D) and you must complete at least 20 points.

Obviously I'd love it if you did more!

You will be asked to bring your work into school in the last week of term, so make sure that you don't leave it until the last minute. You will get the chance to show your work to the rest of the class. Make sure you know which pieces of work have how many points.

I suggest you try to complete at least 1 activity every 2 weeks although you could do the 2 point activities more often.
