<u>Phonics</u>

We are enjoying Storytime Phonics. Every week we learn 4 phonemes that have new graphemes. This week it was aw, wh, ph and ie. They can be found in the small yellow phonics books, and supported by spellings in the small red books. We are not testing their spelling - the aim is to support their phonics learning. Please practice spellings! Vocab:

Phoneme – unit of sound letter(s) make Grapheme – letters making the sound Digraph – 2 letter grapheme to make a sound (ay)

Trigraph - 3 letter grapheme to make a sound (igh)

Split digraph - 2 letter grapheme split by a letter in the middle to make a sound (o-e in phone) usually a long vowel sound

Thank you to the children who taught their parents what we have been learning in class last week. This week we have been learning about 2D and 3D shapes. This will tie into our topic and artwork. Please give your child the opportunity to teach you about this and have a go at the questions.
