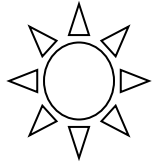

This week we have been learning:-

English: We have been writing a discussion text as a class entitled 'Should children be made to wear school uniform?'. From this, the children chose their own question to discuss and have been writing a balanced discussion. We have also learnt about noun phrases and how these can be used to create a feeling within a sentence.

Spellings: The pattern this week and next week is the letter string 'ough'. This pattern is in many words and has about 7 different sounds including 'ow', 'or', and 'uff'.

Maths: This week we have revised acute, obtuse and right angles. We have also found out how many degrees there are in these angles, how many degrees are in a whole turn and how many are in half a turn. We have begun to learn how to use a protractor.

Homework Tasks.

English:

Think of 3 nouns.

Write 2 sentences for each noun making sure that you include a noun phrase. Try to make the 2 different sentences have a different 'feeling'.

Eg. The mysterious, foggy forest hid a crumbling castle amid its trees and shrubs.

The sun shone through the leaves of the trees in the softly shaded forest.

Maths:

Draw 4 different triangles.

Label the angles and decide whether they are acute, obtuse or right angles.

Estimate how many degrees each angle might be.

If you have a protractor at home, measure the angles and see how close you were.
