



Pupil Premium Grant

The Pupil Premium Grant is funding which the government gives to schools to support children in their learning. The amount of funding we receive through the Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) is calculated on the number of children registered for Free School Meals within the school.

Schools will only receive the PPG funding if families sign up for the Free School Meal entitlement. Our school will receive £1300 per year for your child if you register for this.

The funding will be used for:

- Extra support and 1:1 tuition
- Challenge and support group tuition
- Reduced rates for music lessons, clubs and class visits
- Financial support with uniform costs

You will qualify for PPG if you are in receipt of one of the following:

- Income Support (IS) or
- Child Tax Credit, provided they are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual taxable income (as assessed by The Inland Revenue) which from 6 April 2011 does not exceed £16,190
- Income-Based Job Seekers' Allowance (IB JSA) or
- Employment Support Allowance (Income Related) (ASA(IRA)) or
- Guaranteed Element of State Pension Credit
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
