

Year 4 P.I.P. Homework week 2 10.9.18

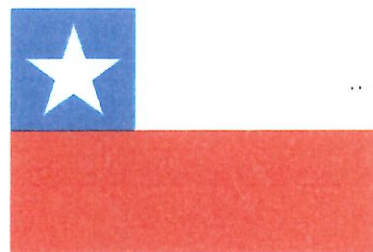
