Topic Tasks: Summer Week 3

Topic

Thank-you for all the excellent homework this week and anticipated brilliant spelling test results! We will be sending homework books home on a Monday and asking you to return the homework plus book and we'll testing spellings the following Monday.



In literacy we are writing question and statement sentences.

What is the girl using to catch butterflies? (question mark)

This is a picture you could colour with crayons. (full stop)

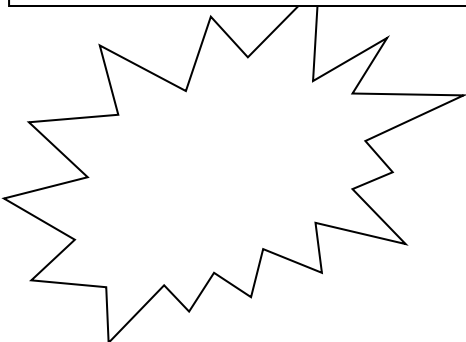
Look at the picture above can you write three question and three statement sentences about it?

Remember neat joined writing, spaces between words and correct spellings.

Maths Children need to know how to make the same money total using different coins, $2 \times 50p = £1$ or $10 \times 10p = £1$. How many different coin combinations can you find to make 20p? Record the different ways. Number bonds $15 + 5 = 20$ helps work out $20 - ? = 15$, so $? = 5$ in this calculation. $25 + 5 = 30$, $35 + 15 = 50$, $45 + 25 = 70$, $55 + 35 = 90$ and $65 + 45 = 110$. Use these to work out the 5 sums opposite and write the sums in your book. Record your work neatly!

1. $30 - ? = 5$
2. $50 - ? = 35$
3. $70 - ? = 25$
4. $90 - ? = 55$
5. $110 - ? = 45$
