## <u>Maths</u>

This week we have been revising measures. We have revisited finding the area and perimeter of shapes, finding the volume of cubes and cuboids and solving problems involving lengths, mass, capacity and time. For example. Three fifths of a bottle of cooking oil is used. 450ml is left. How much oil does a full bottle hold?

So... If 3/5 has been used, the 450ml is 2/5. Therefore  $450 \div 2 = 225$  which is 1/5. 1/5 x 5 = the whole, so  $225g \times 5 = 1,125g$  or 1.125kg.
