This week we have continued to work on Phase 4 phonics -consonant blends. We have looked in particular at word endings. The 4 new sounds are listed below together with previous week's sounds.

Perhaps you could continue to work on sound games such as having a number of cards with words containing these sounds and asking the children to sort the words according to the sounds they contain. Every week we will continue to inform you of the consonant blends we have taught to help you reinforce this work at home.
