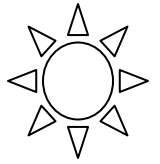


# Parents in Partnership

This week we have been learning:-

## English:

This week we have been looking at War Poetry. We started with 'In Flanders Field' which was the inspiration for the poppy commemoration and have then looked at different poems written by children and adults about war. The children have practiced reciting one of them in groups or individually. We moved on to looking at the imagery in the poems including personification and similes.

Spellings: This week we have learnt about homophones and near homophones.

Maths: In maths this week, we have looked at graphs and timetables and have learnt how to find information from them.
