A reminder of this extract from our uniform policy: *In the interests of hygiene and safety, children's hair should be tied back if it is long enough to reach the shoulders. Hairstyles should be smart, and not extreme in nature, as these styles can become a distraction, or a source of social isolation. This includes tramlines, colours or 'Mohican' styles - if in doubt please ask first. Hair accessories should be discrete and reflect the school colours. Parents should also be aware that tattoos and nail polish are not permitted. Children wearing inappropriate hair accessories will be asked to remove them.*
