Topic Tasks: Summer Week 6

Topic

This topic, about Spring, is coming to an end and we will be starting our new topic after half-term. Our Topic will be about Transport: land, sea and air. We hope your children enjoyed their Royal Wedding afternoon tea on Friday and eating the sandwiches they made!

In literacy we are learning how to write a recount. As there has just been a Royal wedding your homework is to write four to five sentences recounting either the Royal Wedding or another celebration you have enjoyed, maybe a birthday or family event. Remember neat joined writing, spaces between words and correct spellings.

Maths Your children are learning how to find $\frac{1}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ of numbers using the division facts they know. To find a $\frac{1}{4}$ of a number, divide the number by 4 and find $\frac{3}{4}$ of the number after finding a $\frac{1}{4}$ multiply the answer by 3. $\frac{1}{4}$ of 12 = $12 \div 4 = 3$.

So finding $\frac{3}{4}$ of 12 is $12 \div 4 = 3$ then $3 \times 3 = 9$
