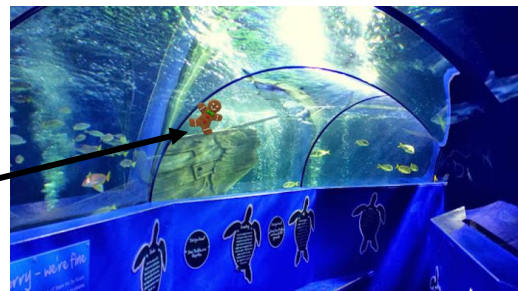

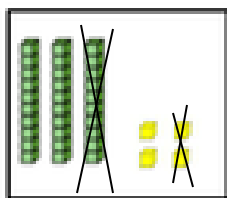
Have you seen this Gingerbread Man?
