RE WAGBAT: exploring the symbols of Pentecost.

Peter spoke to the crowd. He told them how God had raised Jesus from the dead and that he had been a witness to this. He told the crowd that they must be baptised so that they too would receive the Holy Spirit.

That day, three thousand people were baptised. It was the birthday of the church.



Symbols of Pentecost

Christians believe that they receive the Holy Spirit when they accept Christ and become Christians. They believe that the Holy Spirit never leaves them and therefore, God never leaves them.

They believe that the Holy Spirit teaches them, comforts them and helps them to do the right thing.

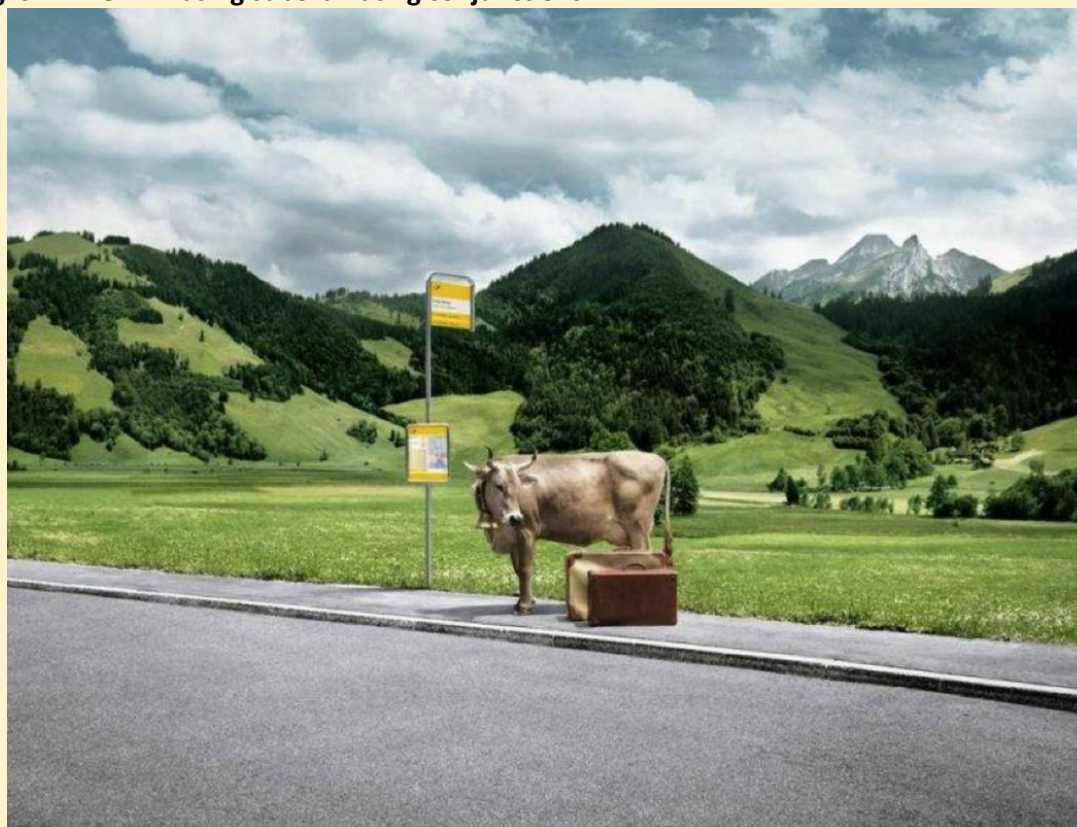
During Pentecost, red is used in the church and often, the ministers will wear red. The symbol of the flames that appeared above the disciples' heads will also be seen.

Sometimes the symbol of the dove is used to represent the Holy Spirit. This is because earlier in Jesus' life, when He was baptised, a dove brought the Holy Spirit to Jesus.

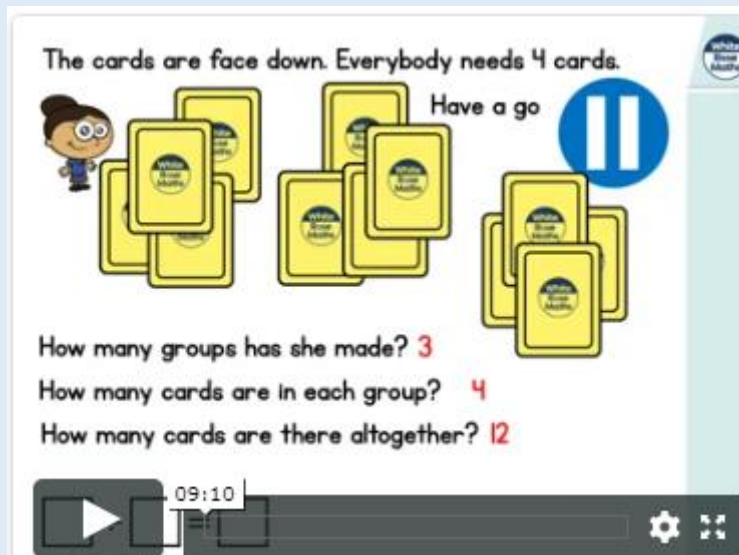

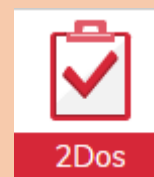
Our Wednesday Computing lesson has again been set by Mr. Tuson.
