Maths

This week we have been working on geometry. We've been learning about co-ordinates, translating and reflecting shapes on a full co-ordinate grid. The children have worked very hard and used these skills to solve some challenging reasoning problems.

Literacy and Topic

Literacy

In our Literacy we have started learning about persuasive texts. The children have written a persuasive letter to the governors this week asking for permission to go on a school trip to Florida! Some were very convincing!

We have also continued reading Pig Heart Boy and have followed Cameron on his journey to the hospital where he will have his operation.

Spelling and Grammar

For SpaG this week we have revisited synonyms and antonyms in order to develop our vocabulary. We have also revised the rules for adding prefixes and suffixes as well as using, main, subordinate and relative clauses in sentences.

During our spelling lessons we have learnt the rules for -cial and -tial endings. For example:

- Cial comes after a vowel (e.g. special, artificial)
- Tial comes after a consonant (e.g. essential, potential)
