was that we had found. We found jewelry, coins, pottery, items of furniture, a shield, sword and lots more! Then we laid it all out and worked out what person it would have been. We then went up to Roman part of the museum to look at some more artefacts and find out about the Romans in Dumovaria (Dorchester). We then headed for some lunch and afterwards walked to the Roman Town House site. We started off in the grounds looking at what would have been the kitchen and pantry and saw where the under floor heating would have been. Then we put some shoe covers on and headed into the house itself to see the wonderful mosaic floors. It was brilliant! We finished with a photo on the steps that had been built to look like an amphitheatre! We had such a brilliant day!
