

Here are some creative ways to help your child learn their spellings.

<p align="center">1. ABC Order</p>  <p>Write all of your spelling words in alphabetical (ABC) order.</p>	<p align="center">2. Word Parts</p> <p>Write your words. Then use a coloured pencil to divide the words into syllables. e.g. <u>jump</u>ing cater<u>pill</u>ar</p>	<p align="center">3. Other Handed</p> <p>Write each word 5 times, switching the hand you write it with each time. Say the word as you spell it.</p>	<p align="center">4. Vowel Spotlight</p> <p>Write your words using one colour for the vowels and another colour for the consonants. (vowels: a, e, i, o, u)</p>
<p align="center">5. Use Technology</p> <p>Type out your spelling words on the computer. Try to use at least 4 different fonts.</p> 	<p align="center">6. Pyramid Words</p> <p align="center">s sp spe spel spell spelli spelling spelling spelling</p> <p>(or make them boat shaped, star, smiley face, etc.)</p>	<p align="center">7. "Ransom" Words</p> <p>"Write" your words by cutting letters out of a newspaper or magazine and gluing the letters on a piece of paper to spell your words.</p> 	<p align="center">8. Rainbow Words</p> <p>Write your spelling words with coloured pencils. Make each letter a different colour.</p> 
<p align="center">9. Scrambled Words</p> <p>Write your words. Then write them again with the letters mixed up. Can you unscramble them again the next day? e.g. watch - cwhta</p>	<p align="center">10. Silly Sentences</p> <p>Write 3 or more sentences that use all your spelling words.</p> 	<p align="center">11. Prefixes and Suffixes</p> <p>Underline the prefixes and suffixes in the words you are learning. Make sure you know what they mean. e.g. <u>im</u>portant happ<u>iness</u></p>	<p align="center">12. Word Search</p> <p>Create your own word search with your spellings. Show the answers to your puzzle in a different colour.</p> 
<p align="center">13. Flashcards</p> <p>Make and practice with flashcards. Put the word on one side and definition (meaning) on the other.</p> 	<p align="center">14. Picture & a Story</p> <p>Draw a picture defining each word. Write a sentence about your picture using the word.</p>	<p align="center">15. Words without Vowels</p> <p>Write all of your words replacing vowels with a line. Go back and see if you can fill in the vowels. e.g. q--st--n = question</p>	<p align="center">16. Train Words</p> <p>Write the entire list end-to-end as one long word. Write each new word in a different colour. e.g. <u>train</u><u>back</u><u>stop</u></p>
<p align="center">17. Write a Story, Poem or Song with Words</p> <p>Write a story using all your spelling words. Underline the words you used.</p>	<p align="center">18. Bubble Letters</p> <p>Write your spelling words out in bubble writing.</p> 	<p align="center">19. Words Within Words</p> <p>Write each spelling word and then write at least 2 words made from that word. e.g. catch - cat, hat</p>	<p align="center">20. Picture words</p> <p>Draw a picture and hide your spelling words in the picture.</p>
