This week we finished off our DT unit and made seasonal tarts. Before half term, the children chose the vegetables they wanted to use when making them and decided how they were going to have their veg- peeled, sliced diced, grated, cubed. We hope you enjoy eating them at home! In English we have started to look at persuasive writing. We watched adverts and read some posters where we looked out for the features. We have started learning about Europe in Geography. We discussed what tourism is and then labelled a map of Europe with some counties. We also talked about which countries in Europe we have been to and why we might have been there. We used words such as landmark, climate and city.

#### Maths

This week we have been learning to tell the time using digital and analogue clocks. The children have found the analogue clock particular tricky. It would be great if you could practice this at home. Using: o'clock, quarter past, quarter to, half past and telling the time to 5 minutes. Using phrases like '25 to 12' '10 to 3' '5 past 8' '20 past 6'.
