
## Home Learning

Year 2 have had a fantastic week of learning! In Maths, we have been exploring the concept of time, looking at analogue clocks and practising telling the time to O'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to, as well as up to the nearest five minutes. Time can be a tricky area of learning but the children showed great enthusiasm and perseverance this week! Parents can support this learning at home by asking children to read the time throughout the day, use a timer for activities, or talk about what time daily routines happen. In English, we enjoyed beginning our learning on the story Grandad's Secret Giant, and using the town and characters as inspiration for some descriptive and informative writing. In Geography, we have been learning about four different types of bodies of water – rivers, lakes, seas, and oceans – and how they are similar and different. Over in DT, the children showed great concentration and determination as they learned how to do a running stitch – a brilliant step in developing their sewing skills! We will use this new skill to learn to make our very own felt pouches this half term, which the children are very excited about! Well done for another great week of learning, Year 2!
