#### This week, our gospel value was integrity. The certificates were awarded to Leo and Mckenzie

We have had another successful week. In Maths, we have continued to learn about time. This week, looking at durations and start and end times. In English, we have been learning about adverts and what language is used to persuade people to buy products. We had a go at writing our own rhetorical questions and planned our own advert that we will write and record next week. In DT, we finished off the unit by evaluating our tarts that we made last week. In Geography, we are looking at tourism around Europe. We looked at the Amalfi Coast and came up with reasons why people would want to visit there and what attracts tourists. We have started our new branch in RE this week. We have started by learning about the Jewish festival of Passover. We had a look at the Seder plate and what foods are on them. We drew our own plate and wrote the meaning of each item.

#### Maths

We have been learning to tell the time using digital and analogue clocks. The children have found the analogue clock particular tricky. It would be great if you could practice this at home. Using: o'clock, quarter past, quarter to, half past and telling the time to 5 minutes. Using phrases like '25 to 12' '10 to 3' '5 past 8' '20 past 6'.

In this session, children will learn about the wider Church and its mission to reflect the Holy Trinity through love for others. This session will also introduce the principles of Catholic Social Teaching (from 'Together For The Common Good'), which will be explored further in the next unit.
