Reading	Times Table Rock Stars
<p>Please read at least <b>5 times over the week</b>.</p> <p>Remember that from next Wednesday your child will start bringing home their books. Please remember to write in their reading journals so we can count their reads.</p> <p>Remember that in their daily phonics lessons the children participate in reading activities.</p>	<p>Times Table Rock Stars allows the children to practice their times tables. Children in Year 1 practise counting in 10s, 5s and 2s.</p> <p>PLEASE NOTE THE CHILDREN HAVE ACCESS TO ALL THE TIMES TABLES SO PLEASE CONTINUE TO HELP THEM DEVELOP THEIR SKILLS, especially if they are now on 33, 44 or 55 club.</p>

Splat square is a teaching tool that you can use at home, especially when working on your child's 2s, 5s and 10 times tables. The children can use the 100 square to 'splat' their multiples of 2s, 5s or 10s and spot the patterns they have made. It's also very good when identifying and splatting odd and even numbers.
