Reminders:

3. In P.S.H.E next week, the session will be focussing on reaching out. Building on pupils' learning in the previous session about Catholic Social Teaching (CST), this session recaps the principles and shows how they are relevant day to day. Children will look at current news stories, applying Catholic Social Teaching to analyse the issues and come up with ways of reaching out to others and spreading God's love in their communities.
