We are back for another exciting half term and it has been a lovely start with lots of children very keen to be back with their friends!

Drop off - Now that the children have settled and are confident with routines, we ask that when you drop your child off in the morning that you wait and say goodbye at the door and encourage them to put their drinks, bags etc. away independently. This also helps to ensure the area doesn't get too busy.

RWI groups and home learning - From Autumn 2, the children move into groups for Read, Write Inc. lessons rather than being taught as a whole class. This ensures that we can support and challenge children appropriately. As a result, your child will bring home phonics home learning tasks matched to what their group are focusing on. We will make sure they are given the

correct sheets each Friday.

You may have also noticed that your child has brought home a sound blending book on Wednesday this week as well as their reading for pleasure books. The sound blending book is their Read, Write Inc. book linked to the sounds and words they have practiced reading in school that week. This should be looked at with them daily so that children can practice fred talking and saying the words. Try to encourage your child to have a go at this independently by asking them to "fred talk" and "read the word" before supporting them.

Please return these books to school every Wednesday as they will then be swapped for the next book. There is a replacement cost for lost books.
