Method

- Place 1 egg in each cup. Pour vinegar into the cup until the egg is completely covered. The egg must be completely covered or the experiment will not work.
- Place the cup somewhere where it will not be moved.
- The experiment will take 3 4
 days to complete. Children can
 observe the changes each day
 and record the results.
- 4. After 3 4 days, remove the egg from the vinegar and carefully place on to paper towels. There will be a white residue left on the egg. This can either be left on the egg or washed off. To wash off residue, gently place under the tap and it should easily wash off. Washing off the residue will make it easier to see the inside of the egg.

Safety Notice: Be sure to have all children handling the eggs to wash their hands immediately after the experiment or if they come in contact with an egg that has burst. Also caution the children against putting their hands in their mouths during the experiment. All surfaces should be sanitized after the experiment is complete.

You will need:

vinegar - the amount will depend on how many eggs you choose to do, approximately 1-2 cups per egg.

large plastic cups - 1 cup per egg

paper towels
