<b>2 points</b>	Visit the King's Statue in Weymouth. Find out who the King is and why he has a statue in Weymouth.	Find out how far the Jurassic Coast extends. Create a fact file with the most important facts.	Design a new front cover for the book Bone Girl, Stone Girl.	Make a list of as many different dinosaurs as you can. Make sure that you spell them correctly.
<b>5 points</b>	Make a poster to explain how a Victorian person might enjoy the seaside. You could include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The Pier</li> <li>• The Esplanade</li> <li>• A Bathing machine</li> </ul>	Create a poster to explain how Chesil Beach is formed. Find out about the pebbles and include facts about the type of rocks that can be found along our coastline. You could even visit Chesil Beach and take photos.	Draw a picture of Mary Anning finding her 'sea monster'. Make it as detailed as possible to show the dinosaur appearing.	Practise spelling the different types of rocks so that you are confident you can spell them correctly and that you know what they mean
<b>10 points</b>	Create a model of a bathing machine. Add details that would help someone to understand what it is, why it was used and who used it. You could include some interesting facts to inform people about its use.	Investigate the formation of either Lulworth Cove or Durdle Door. Create either a model or a detailed diagram showing how they were formed.	Create a model of the plesiosaur. You could use clay, playdoh, salt dough, Lego, junk modelling items or anything else you have available	Write a diary entry as Mary describing the day you found the plesiosaur.

You can choose which activities you do from this grid.

You must complete an activity from each area (A-D) and you must complete at least 20 points.

Obviously I'd love it if you did more!

You will be asked to bring your work into school in the last week of term, so make sure that you don't leave it until the last minute.  
You will get the chance to show your work to the rest of the class. Make sure you know which pieces of work have how many points.

I suggest you try to complete at least 1 activity every 2 weeks although you could do the 2 point activities more often.
